Rule	Rules and laws are guidelines for how people should behave. They are based on ideas about what is right and wrong.	Islam	Islam is an Arabic word meaning submission and obedience. It comes from a word meaning peace. Like Christians and Jews, Muslims are monotheistic which means they only believe in one God, who they call Allah.
Routine	A standard or regular way of doing something.	The Five Pillars	The five pillars – the declaration of faith (shahada), prayer (salah), alms-giving (zakat), fasting (sawm) and pilgrimage (hajj) – constitute the basic norms of Islamic practice
Rights	A right is something a person has that people think should not be taken away from them.	Jews	Jews believe that there is only one God. They believe they have a special agreement with God called a covenant. Jews promise to obey God's laws to say thank you to him for looking after them.
Responsibility	Responsibility means being dependable, making good choices, and taking accountability for your actions.	10 Commandments	The Ten Commandments establish rules of worship and forbid actions such as murder, theft, and adultery.




A rule is something that should be obeyed. To obey is to do what someone tells you to do or what a rule, law, etc., says you must do. A routine is the usual series of things that you do at a particular time. A routine is also the practice of regularly doing things in a fixed order. Rules are something that must be followed. Routines are the order that we do things.

A right is something a person has that people think should not be taken away from them. Eg the right to life, survival and development. the right to have their views respected and to have their best interests considered at all times.

Responsibility means being dependable, making good choices, and taking accountability for your actions. Responsibility means you do the things you are supposed to do and accept the results of your actions. A responsibility is something you are expected to do.

The Five Pillars of Islam are fundamental practices in Islam, considered to be obligatory acts of worship for all Muslims. The 5 pillars are the shahadah, salat, zakat, saum, and hajj. Muslims pray facing Mecca five times a day: at dawn, noon, mid-afternoon, sunset, and after dark.

The 10 Commandments were essentially laws spoken by God to Moses on Mount Sinai and then written on stone tablets. Put God first, No fake gods, Respect God's name, Respect God's day of rest, Respect your parents, Do not kill people, Respect marriage and Do not steal. Christians and Jews believe the Ten Commandments are important rules from God that tell Christians how to live.
