## English

In English children will study 'George's Marvellous Medicine' by Roald Dahl. They will explore, interpret and respond to the text, developing and using appropriate vocabulary.

They will write for a range of purposes including character descriptions, poetry, narratives and non-chronological reports. They will reread and evaluate writing to check it makes sense and make simple revisions. They will participate in debate and discussion and be offered opportunities to justify their opinions.



## Spelling

In spelling children will be learning how to add the suffixes -ed, -ing, -er and -est to root words. They will also continue to learn how to spell many common homophones and how to use apostrophes correctly.

## Mathematics

In Maths children will apply and use efficient methods to calculate using their understanding of place value and the number system for the four operations. They will solve problems involving fractions, money and time. They will develop their understanding of shape; they will use angles and positional language. Children will consolidate counting in steps of 2, 3, 5, 10, and practise counting in 20s, 25s and 100s. They will continue to develop mental maths strategies.

### **Challenge:**

Practise telling the time to 5 minute intervals and counting money. Continue to play on Mathletics.

## Book Club

As part of our book club the children can choose their favourite Roald Dahl story. This is a book the children can enjoy with a grown-up at home.

## Science

In Science we will develop our knowledge about humans and investigate and describe the basic needs for human survival. We will discuss and learn about the importance of food, exercise and hygiene.

## Art

In Art children will look at printed designs. They will use their own printing blocks to create printed artwork which they will evaluate.



## RE

In RE our topic is: Me, my family and friends. The children will consider their own and different types of families, they will think about relationships and groups to which they belong. They will learn about some Bible stories linked to families.



## PSHE

In PSHE we will focus on the UNICEF Article 'You have the right to a healthy life'.

## PE

In P.E the children will develop their skills and agility by participating in rounders and team games in preparation for sports day. They will begin to link skills and actions within simple games and understand some concepts of game – opponent and team mate. They will discuss the importance of being active.



## DT

In DT children will investigate, design and make printing blocks from a variety of materials.

## Music

In Music children will reflect, rewind and replay. They will consolidate their learning this year linked to the interrelated elements of music by singing, playing instruments, composing and improvising.



## Geography

In Geography children will develop their place and location knowledge of the UK. Using locational and directional language children will describe locations and features on a map. They will draw simple maps and plans using keys.

## Trips

As part of our Geography learning we will visit Poulton Hall and Gardens.
