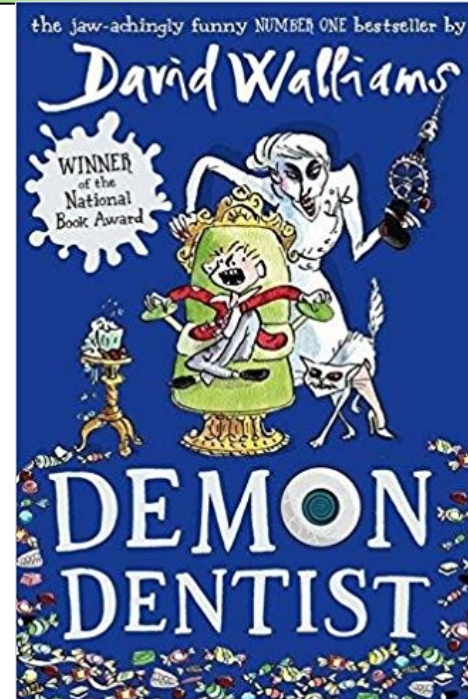

How many dance styles can you think of?

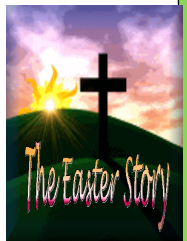
In **Geography** children will learning about how health and tooth care varies around the world and why (Global)
