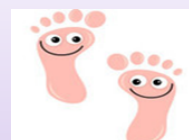
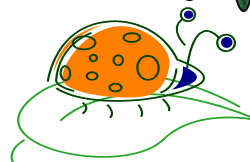

Literacy

We will be exploring the features of fiction and non-fiction texts and using books to find out different facts about plants and animals. We will then use what we have found out about plants and animals to make information booklets. We will look at books in detail, including 'Aaaarrgghh Spider!' by Lydia Monks, 'What the ladybird heard' by Julia Donaldson, 'Yucky worms' by Viven French 'The very hungry caterpillar' by Eric Carle. We will also be writing stories about different characters, using mini beasts as a focus.

Challenge! Can you make an information booklet about your favourite mini beast?

Phonics

In phonics, we will continue with Phase 3 and 4 sounds, and tricky words and applying these new sounds to our reading, spelling and writing.

Phase 3 sounds and tricky words:-

Tricky words :- he, she, we, me, be, you, are, her, was, all, they, my

Phase 4 We will be learning the initial and final blends and new tricky words.

Phonics

Maths

We will continue to explore doubling and halving using objects and develop our ability to work out problems in our heads. We will continue to develop our skills in addition and subtraction and writing out number sentences, using number lines and counters to help us to work them out. We will continue to learn our number bonds to ten as well as exploring different ways of making numbers from 1-20 and beyond. With adult support, we will develop our ability to solve problems including word problems and money problems and will use what we have learned to create our own problems for our friends. During continuous provision, we will continue to make 2D shape patterns and explore the names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

We will continue to talk about how we ask and answer questions and we will use these skills in all areas of our learning. In talk time, we will develop our ability to form an opinion and to speak clearly about what we think and how we feel. We will be working with different talking partners and in groups to develop our speaking and listening skills in preparation for Year One.

We will be focusing on moving into Year One and we will have lots of fun finding out about the exciting things that happen there. We will meet our new teacher and we will get a chance to speak to children in Year One too. We will explore the different areas of the school and go on learning walks. Through our 'Team Building day' we will be working with our big friends in different activities.

Understanding the World

We will be looking at what makes plants grow and exploring what happens when plants are grown in different places. In our outdoor area we will go on mini beast hunts to find out about the animals that live there and observe and make comparisons between them. We will be exploring different programs on the iPads and look at how we can use different media to capture experiences. We will be learning about the different countries taking part in the Rio Olympics.

Challenge! Can you find out about a type of mini beast and make an information booklet about them?

Expressive Arts and Design

We will continue to make 3D models linked to our own interests as well as 3D models of bugs and mini beasts. We will explore the author and illustrator 'Eric Carle' through our focus book 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and we will paint in the style of the illustrator. Through exploring different manmade and natural materials, we will combine the different textures to make collages of different outdoor scenes. In music, we will continue to find the pulse in different songs and continue to build up our repertoire of songs that we have learnt.

Physical Development

We will talk about why it is important to keep healthy during the summer and talk about what we need to do to stay healthy and be safe in the sun. We will develop our skills in different sports and take part in Sports day. We will continue to develop our abilities to work as part of a team and use these skills in the different sports we engage in. We will also practise our cursive handwriting and prepare for Year One. **Challenge!** Can you write sentences using cursive letters?
