¿Qué fecha es hoy? What's the date today?	Hoy es martes, 4 de julio. Today it's Tuesday 4 th July.
¿Qué fecha fue ayer? What was the date yesterday?	Ayer fue lunes, 3 de julio. Yesterday it was Monday 3 rd July.
¿Qué fecha será mañana? What will the date be tomorrow?	Mañana será miércoles, 5 de julio. Tomorrow it will be Wednesday 5 th July.

Remember...

Day names and months are not given capital letters in Spanish, unless they are at the beginning of a sentence.
