As mathematicians we will...

- ...placing numbers on number lines and sequencing them.
- ...learn how to count in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.
- ...continue to develop our addition and subtraction skills and learn how to add a 3-digit number and hundreds.
- ...learn about multiplication and division, using mental methods and progressing to formal written methods

As musicians we will...

- ... play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, control and expression.
- ... use voices expressively by singing songs, chants and rhymes.

As readers we will...

- ... read texts linked to taking care of the environment including 'Tin Forest' and 'The Creakers'
- ... examine and understand the meaning of vocabulary in context
- ... retrieve answers to questions from fiction and non-fiction text
- ...continue to develop reading fluency
