Learning Letter and Extended Home Learning Challenges

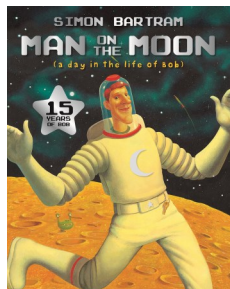

English

The children will be studying 'Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartram. We will consider story settings and plot development. The children will write a range of genres including a recount, instructions, character descriptions and narratives.

Spelling

In spelling we be focusing on the following spelling patterns, silent k, w and g, words ending in 'le', 'el' and al'. The children will also learn how to spell some common homophones. Additionally, the children will learn how to use apostrophes in contracted words and for possession.

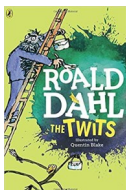
Mathematics

In Maths children will work on a range of activities including reading, writing and comparing numbers, odd and even, counting on and back in 100s, addition and subtraction methods, doubling and halving. We will learn multiplication and division facts and use these to solve problems.

Art & DT

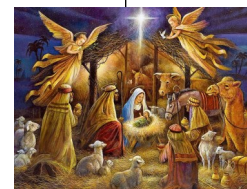

Music

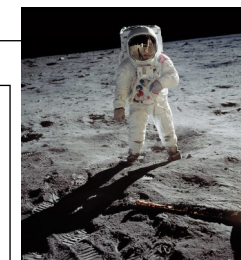
In Music the children and will be rehearsing songs for the school Christmas play.
