I really liked learning about fractions and making boxes out of felt.

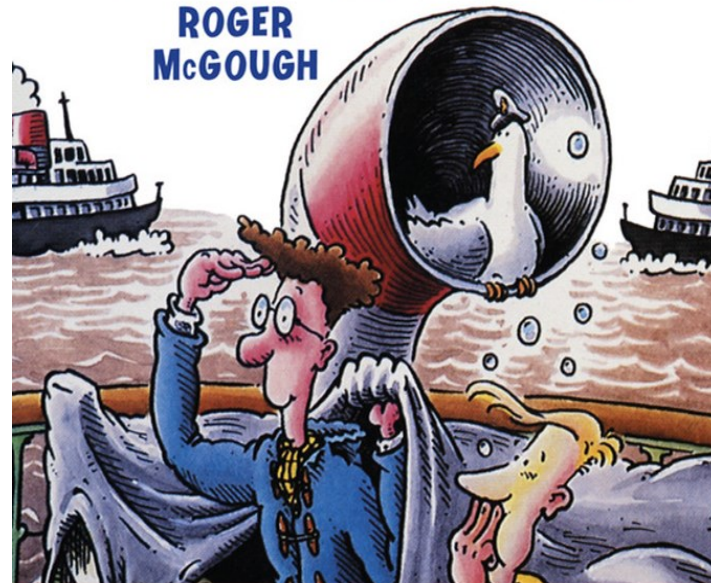

English:

In **English** lessons we will be delving into the world of Roger McGough and the Stowaways. We will be writing our own chapters in the same style as Roger as well as recounts and diaries. We will also be using our history topic of the Anglo-Saxons and Beowulf as inspiration to write our own myths.

In **Maths** children will be continuing consolidating their methods in the four operations, developing strategies both mental and written approaches. They will be learning how to convert between analogue and digital time, comparing geometric shapes and identifying angles

In **science** our topic will be about how we hear sounds and ways that sound waves can be controlled. We will also be identifying how the ear works.

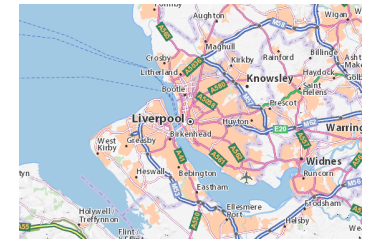
**Challenge!** Can you find a way that we can muffle sound?

In **Geography** children will learning about the changes to our local environment and how Roger McGough was inspired by the coastline of NW.

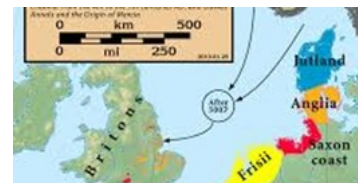


In **MFL** the children will continue to learn to speak and write conversational Spanish.

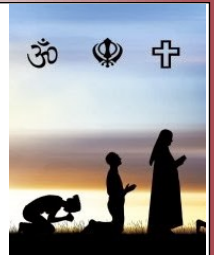
In **Music** children will continue their lessons with Mrs Hamilton using the topic Let your spirit fly.
