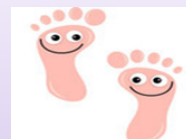

**Learning Letter and Extended Home Learning Challenges

Literacy

We will be learning to write our 1st names and surname. We will be experimenting with writing and mark making materials, including pencils, sand and paint. We will be listening and responding to stories and rhymes.

Through our Literacy lessons we will look at books, including 'Owl Babies' and we will get to know the Oxford Reading Tree family! We will be listening to poems and learning to rhyme words e.g. cat, hat, mat, hen, pen, den etc.

Challenge! - Practise reading and writing your full name.



Phonics

We will be learning the alphabet and through our phonics learning to say the name and sound of the letters. Then we will be practising writing the sounds and letter we have learnt. We will start with Phase 2 sounds and tricky words.

Maths

In maths we will be counting and matching objects to the numbers. We will be learning to recognise our numbers and use the language of more or less. We will count regular and irregular arrangements. Basic addition and subtraction more or less. We will learn to measure and find out how long objects are and order them. We will create and recreate patterns using shapes. We will learn the names of 2D shapes and use positional language.

Challenge! What number can you count to? Can you match numbers to different amounts of objects? Can you count backwards?

Communication & Language

We will be learning to be a good listener and a good speaker as we make new friends. We will be listening and responding to stories and rhymes. We will be learning how to ask and answer questions.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning about why we are special, talking about our feelings and emotions, learning how to make new friends. We will be learning about our Rights and responsibilities. We will be talking about different jobs and what we want to be when we grow up. We will get to know our Big Year 6 Friends. We will follow the JIGSAW programme Being me in my world.



Understanding the World

We will be learning all about ourselves and our families. We will learn about where we live and how we travel to school.

People who help us in school, home and community.

Exploring computers and how to use them including using ipads, beebots etc.

We will be learning about our bodies and the 5 senses. We will talk about similarities and differences and how I have changed from a baby.

Challenge! Talk to your family about where you live and your address. Draw pictures of your house and family.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be exploring the creative area and all of the different materials. We will be painting pictures of ourselves and our friends and family and we will be exploring colours and how they can be changed.

In music we will be exploring how sounds can be changed, using instruments and our bodies. We will be joining in with actions, dancing and singing games.

In the role play area, we will dress up and learn to play with others. We will tell stories and create characters using our imagination with the small world toys.



Physical Development

We will be learning to negotiate the space around us. We will be learning how to move in different ways. We will practice balancing and enjoy dancing and moving rhythmically to music. We will be using different tools and learning how to use scissors correctly to cut. Our teachers will be teaching us how to hold our pencils correctly between our two fingers and thumb. We will copy the letters in our names in our special cursive font, using pencils, paint and writing in sand!

This term is all about learning new routines and helping ourselves to become independent learners. We will learn to get changed for PE, how to hold a pencil and how to tidy up after ourselves.

In **Religious Education** we will be learning about why we are special. This will include talking about who we are, special days, birthdays and talking about our feelings.
