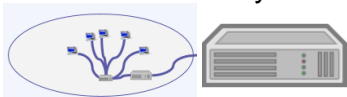
Vocabulary

network	Devices linked together	domain name	Part of a web address that shows who it belongs to.
router	Device linked to network that passes on information to other devices.	copyright	protected information that can't be copied or shared from a web page.
website	Online pages of a single subject or domain	reshare content	Share an image or information with others online.

The internet is known as the World Wide Web and is a **network** of networks. They are connected by a **router**.

We use web address **domain names** to find **websites** that give us information on a subject. There are lots of use features that help us navigate through web pages on each site.

Information on W.W.W. is owned by websites that share it. The owner can be found on a web address. Content is available when allowed but some is **copyright**.
