

Literacy

In writing we will continue to form our letters correctly using our cursive handwriting. We will be learning to write sentences and stories linked to the space books we will be reading. In reading we will be reading key words and apply our phonics skills to decode, segment and blend and read tricky words. In maths we will be counting two sets of objects to find out the total

We will explore the concept of capacity by comparing the sizes of different containers and estimating the amount of liquid they can hold.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be talking about people's different emotions and feelings and how people can have different viewpoints. We will be talking about our own emotions and how we can express them. We will be learning to work together and we will talk about sharing.

Understanding the World

We will be looking at baby animals and adult animals and looking at how they change and will also be comparing different animals. Through play and exploration we will explore IPads and other ICT equipment, including cameras, and will begin to see the importance of ICT in the wider world.
