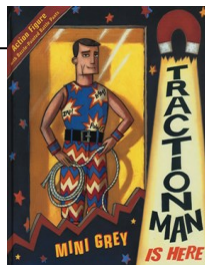

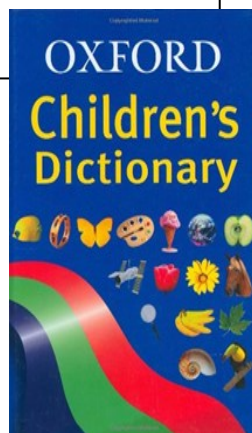
Learning Letter and Extended Home Learning Challenges

Summer 2 2018

In **Literacy** we will be studying a text called "Traction Man is Here!" We will use the text as the basis of our Superheroes topic looking at plot, character and descriptive language. We will role-play; use speaking and listening skills and extended writing to demonstrate our understanding of the text and have lots of fun at the same time! We will also be looking at non-fiction again including how to use a dictionary.



Challenge! Have you got a children's dictionary at home? Ask your adult to generate a word and you could find it in



Phonics / Spelling-We will be reviewing phase 2-5 phonic sounds in preparation for the Statutory Phonics Screening Check. The Phonics Screening will take place during the week beginning 11th June 2018. The screening will consist of 40 words both real and pseudo words. We will continue to learn our Year 1 spelling rules and words and apply them during our independent writing tasks.

In **Mathematics** we will be consolidating the 4 operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be continuing to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will be revisiting how to find halves and quarters of shapes and quantities. Also, we will be learning about mass and weight and using the language heavy/light, heavier than/lighter than. We will then be learning about capacity and volume.

Challenge! Do you have any weighing scales at home? Can you weigh different quantities of ingredients when you bake?

BOOK STUDY!

As it is our final book club in Year 1, we would like the children to bring in their **favourite book** from home for the last week of term to share with the class.

In **Science** we will be continuing to study plants. We will be identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants including deciduous and evergreen trees. We will then be identifying and describing the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants.

In **P.E** children will be playing team games to encourage sportsmanship and the ability to work as a team. **Sports day is Thursday 14th June !**

In **History** we will be looking at the life and achievements of Grace Darling.

Challenge! Can you research Grace Darling's life and find out why she is a real-life hero?

In **Religious Education** we will be at looking at 'What a Wonderful World' by Louis Armstrong in line with the scheme of work "Our Planet."

In **Music** children will be consolidating and revising all of the skills we have learned this year.



In **Computing** we will be creating a digital greetings card which could be used for occasions such as birthdays, thank you or to say good luck in Year 2!

In **DT** we will be using binka and the sewing kits to create a badge for Traction Man. We will be talking about the safety aspect of using sewing needles and will be practising the skill of sewing before attempting the final piece!



PSHE- Circle times will focus on transition into Year 2. The children will be encouraged to talk about their feelings and emotions surrounding transition and visit their new classroom and teacher.
