| F2 | <p>Weekly Attendance F2AG = 94.64% F2AMC = 92.46%</p> <p>Next week the Mounted Police service will be visiting the F2 children with some of their horses. They will be explaining how they use their horses as part of their daily work.</p> |
| Y1 | <p>Weekly Attendance 1SH = 96.3% 1LH = 98.52%</p> <p>The children have been continuing to work hard in all their learning this week. On Seesaw each week we will be uploading phonics words and homework, linked to RWI sounds. There will be real and alien words for the children to practice decoding and blending together. These are practice activities, in a similar format to the Year 1 phonics screening check that takes place in June. The children need to be able to sound them out by identifying the sounds/special friends etc and then read the word.</p> <p>A reminder that your children have access to Mathletics and Spelling Frame for their weekly homework tasks. This is set Monday to Monday. We do encourage all the children to complete the homework tasks. Sometimes additional activities are set on Seesaw. Staff regularly check how the children are progressing through the programmes.</p> |
