

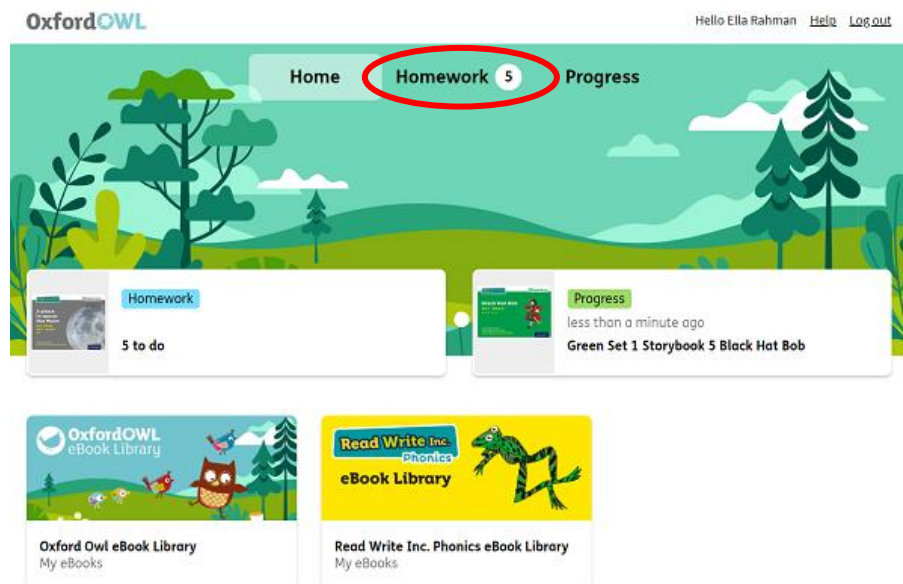

Access to the Read Write Inc. Phonics eBook Library at home

At school, your child is learning to read with **Read Write Inc. Phonics**, a very popular and successful literacy programme published by Oxford University Press.

In order to further support and encourage reading at home, we now have access to RWI Online eBook Library. Your child will be given a username and a password so that they can access their own personal student area on OxfordOwl.co.uk. Once they have [logged in](#), your child can gain access to the resources.

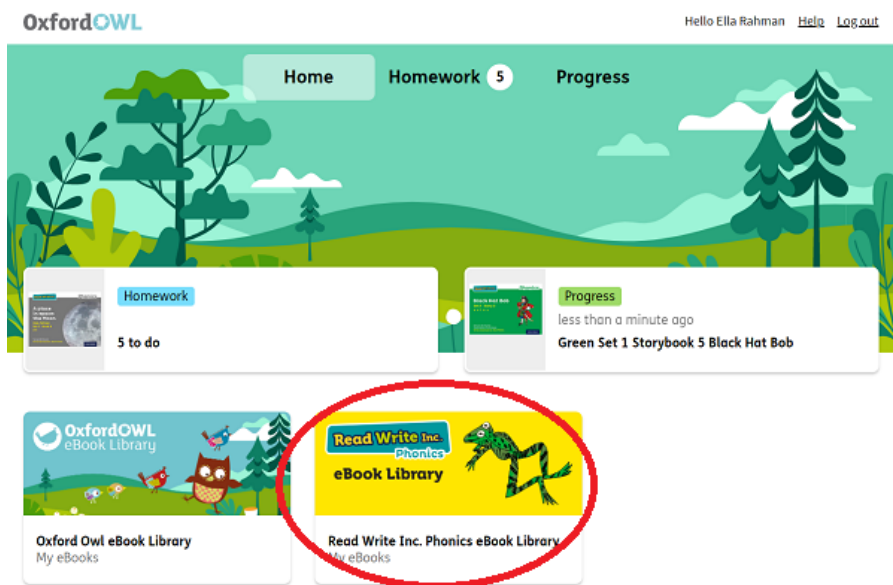


In the homework area, your child will find an eBook, which, has been assigned to them to read – this will normally be the same book that they have brought home with them from school. There may also be a short quiz assigned to your child, enabling them to answer questions relating to the book they have read.

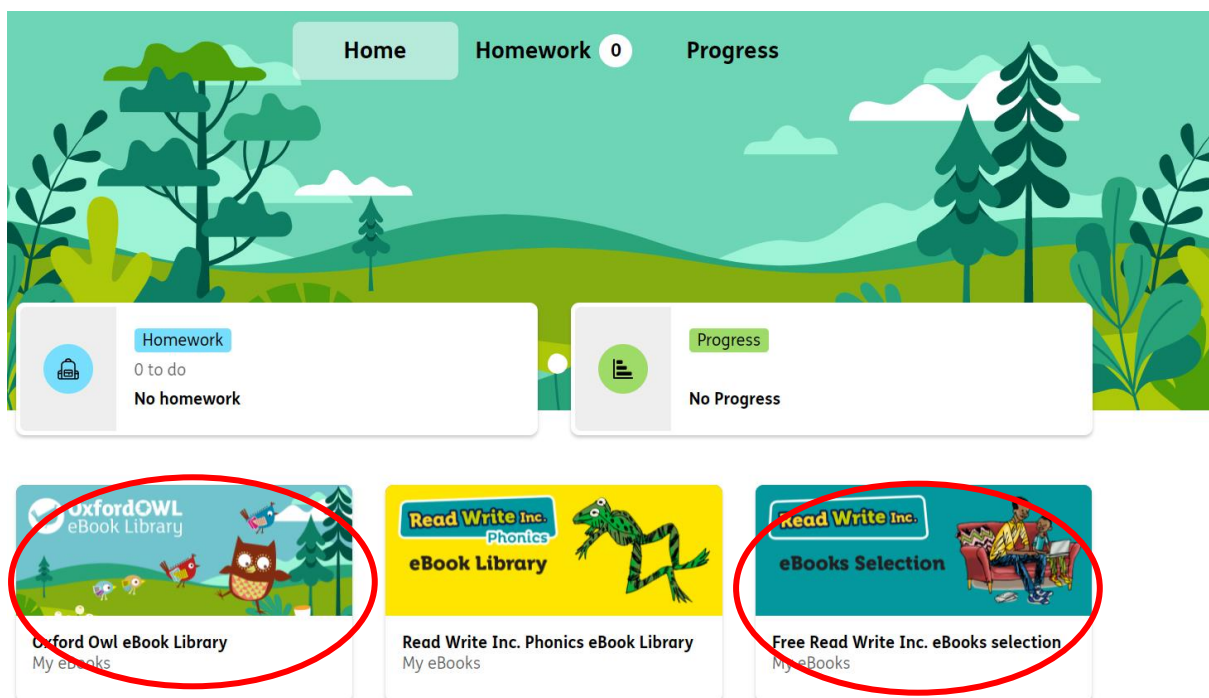
It is an optional activity to read the eBook and/or complete the following quiz. This resource aims to provide an alternative method of reading phonics books and provides optional extended questions to further develop the children's understanding of the book they've read.

Sometimes, teachers may assign books that your child has previously read if they believe that this will further support your child's development in phonics.

Your child can re-read any of their previous eBooks at any time by clicking on Fred Frog:



By clicking on either of these sections, you can gain access to a range of other eBooks. However, these books will not be matched to your child's phonics level and we therefore request that these books are read with or read to the children rather than the children reading them to you.
