Learning Overview

As scientists, we will learn about:

Humans

- Recognise typical characteristics of and name distinct phases of human growth
- Understand the importance for humans of eating the right amount of different types of food.
- Describe the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts and type types of food, and hygiene

Plants

- Develop their understanding further of how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow.
- Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants
- Understand that plant growth is a long process and that plants change their appearance over time as they grow.
- Understand that plants can produce seeds and new plants without human intervention

As musicians, we will learn about:

- Rock n Roll and Reggae music
- Singing, playing, improvising and composing music together to perform in an ensemble
- Listening and appraising various Classic Rock and Reggae songs using musical vocabulary
