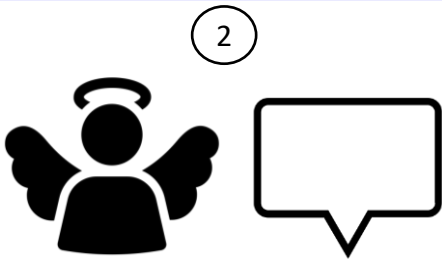
Key Vocabulary

Christianity	Christianity refers to the large group of religions who believe that the son of god was born a man - Jesus of Nazareth - over 2000 years ago. Christians believe Jesus was also Christ (or God), hence the name Christianity.	protection	The word protector in relation to God means: that he protects; He is a defender or guardian to us.

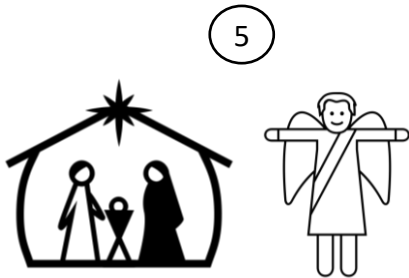
