<u>KS2</u>

You will need to have a hard-boiled egg (ask adults for help) and can decorate it in any way you think is effective including using: felt tips, material or sequins. There will be prizes for 1st place in each class and the winners will be judged on the following:

- Creativity (independent skills)
- Originality and presentation
- Link to the themes given



Good luck and remember to keep your egg in a sealed container (with your name on the bottom) to bring to school. If you make staging for the egg, please keep it to no more than half a cereal box size. If your child would like to take part, please send their decorated eggs into school on the morning of 1st April (not before this date please)
