


## Key Vocabulary


## What?

1. We live in **Wirral** which is in **England**  
 England is in the **United Kingdom**  
**Union/united** means **together**.  
 The United Kingdom is a union of **four countries**.  
**England, Northern Ireland, Scotland** and **Wales**.  
 Ireland is split into 2 countries and **only Northern Ireland** is part of the United Kingdom



4. Know that **human features** are made by humans and they include: **houses, roads and bridges**

Know that **physical features** would be here even if there were no people around and they include **rivers, seas and mountains**



2. The UK is made up of land and water.  
 Know the UK is an **island**. An island is a piece of **land surrounded by water**. These are called **seas and oceans**. Name the seas around the UK - **Irish Sea, North Atlantic Ocean, English Channel, North Sea**  
 Know the **Irish Sea** is the closest to **Wirral** where they live.



3. A **city** is a place where **lots of people live**  
 A **capital city** is a city where the **government** of the country is  
 Know that **London** is the capital city of England and of the UK  
**Belfast** is the capital of Northern Ireland  
**Cardiff** is the capital of Wales  
**Edinburgh** is the capital of Scotland



5. Know **London** is the capital city of England  
 London has many human features including **Big Ben, Houses of Parliament, London Eye and Buckingham Palace**  
 London has one main physical feature **The River Thames**.
